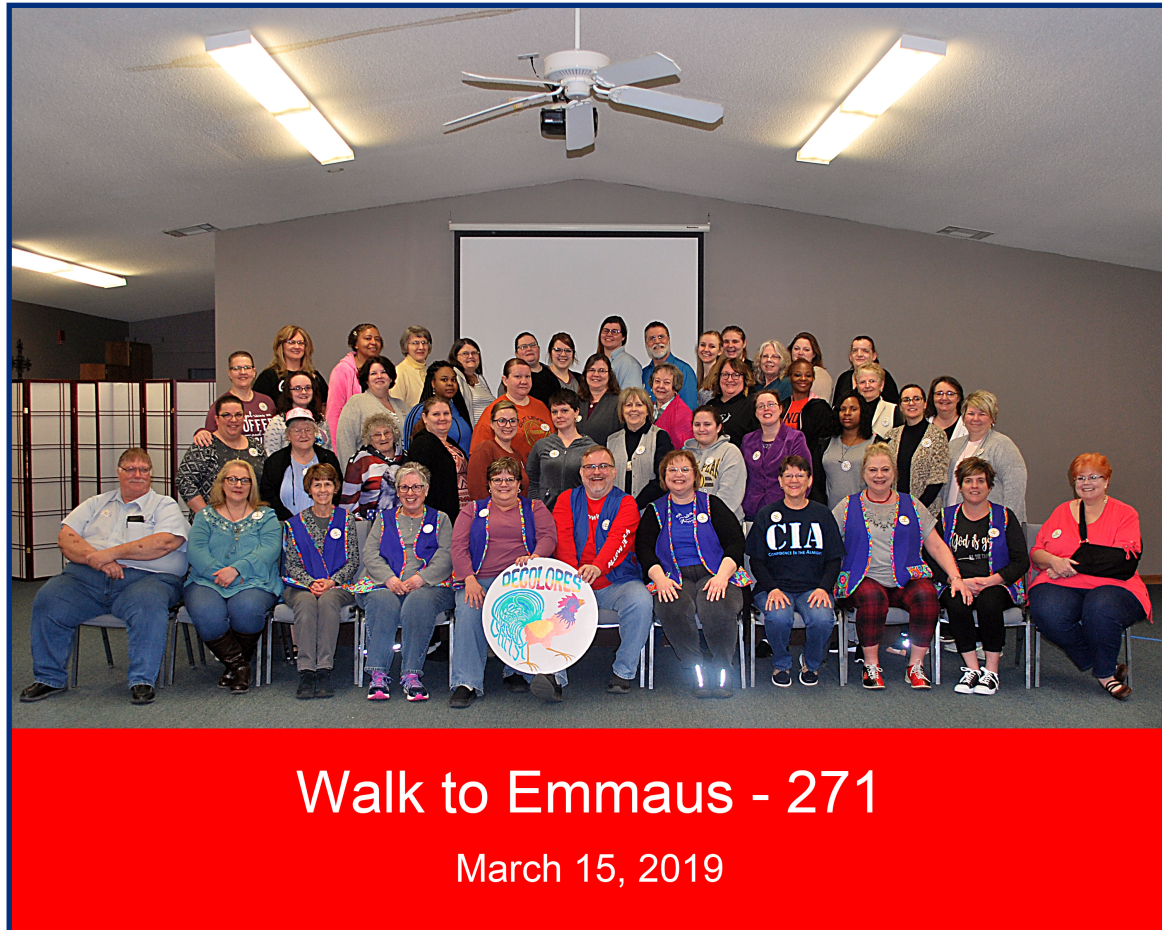
A NEW GOVERNING BOARD
